License Your Pet Online: Go to www.petdata.com and enter your zip code. Under License Now, click "Online." Documentation may be uploaded or submitted later by fax, mail or email. Pay with a major credit card. A convenience fee will apply per transaction. Multiple pets can be licensed in one transaction.

License Your Pet by Mail: Complete the application and mail it with your check or money order made payable to City of Kirkland (please do not send cash), rabies certificate, and proof of spay/neuter, owner's age, or verification of disability if applicable. Paperwork will not be returned. Mail the documents and payments to: Kirkland Animal Licensing, c/o PetData, PO Box 141929, Irving, TX 75014-1929

License In Person: Bring a current rabies certificate, proof of spay/neuter, owner's age, or verification of disability if applicable, and payment to Kirkland City Hall at 123 5th Ave (M-Fr 8-5 excluding holidays), or Kirkland Justice Center at 11750 NE 118th St (M-Fr 7-5 excluding holidays).
