To License Your Pet by Mail: Complete this application, **Enclose a copy of your pet's current rabies vaccination certificate,** Make your check or money order payable to Osceola County Animal Services *(Do not send cash)* **Mail to:** Osceola County Pet Licensing, c/o PetData, PO Box 141929, Irving TX 75014-1929. Paperwork will not be returned.

To License Your Pet In Person: Bring a current rabies certificate and payment to Osceola County Animal Services, located at 3910 Old Canoe Creek Road in St Cloud, or license your pet at a participating veterinary clinic at the time of rabies vaccination.
