## **Licensing Options**

**License Your Dog Online:** O Go to <a href="www.petdata.com">www.petdata.com</a> and enter your zip code. O Under License Now, click "Online." Documentation may be uploaded or submitted later by fax, mail or email. Pay with a major credit card.

**License Your Dog by Mail:** O Complete this application O **Enclose a copy of your pet's current rabies vaccination certificate** O Enclose proof of spay/neuter if it is not indicated on the rabies certificate O Make your check or money order payable to <u>City of Pasco</u> (please do not send cash) O **Mail to:** Pasco Dog Licensing, c/o PetData, PO Box 141929, Irving TX 75014-1929 Documents are not returned – please submit copies of required documents and retain the originals for your records.

## Special Regulations for Potentially Dangerous or Dangerous Dogs

There are special regulations for licensing dogs deemed potentially dangerous and dangerous. Owners are required to register dangerous or potentially dangerous dogs at the Tri-Cities Animal Shelter located at 1312 S. 18th Avenue, Pasco WA 99301. Call (509) 545-3740 regarding these regulations.

The Pasco City Municipal Code (Chapter 6.05.010) defines "potentially dangerous animal" as any animal that when unprovoked: (1) inflicts injury on a human or a domestic animal or livestock, or (b) chases or approaches a person upon the streets, sidewalks, any public grounds, or upon private property other than that of the animal's owner, in a menacing fashion or apparent attitude of attack, or (c) has a known propensity, tendency, or disposition to attack, or to cause injury or otherwise to threaten the safety of humans or domestic animals. There are certain requirements that must be met to maintain potentially dangerous or dangerous dogs in the City limits. Exemptions to the requirements are available in some cases.
